## Bruins ruin GFRR's dual win streak

One of North Dakota's longest and most impressive prep sports winning streaks came to an end on September 15, 2015.

The winning streak of note being Grand Forks Red River's consecutive team dual victories in boys tennis ... 211 straight to be exact.

Fargo South, led by senior David Youngs and sophomore Davis Lawley combined for three of the Bruins' five wins in the highly contested Eastern Dakota Conference team dual. The Bruins also received wins from Carter Steffes (No. 4 singles) and Noah Johnson (No. 5 singles) to seal the landmark victory.

"We knew we had a very good team and that if we worked hard that special things could happen," said Youngs, who won both in singles and doubles. "It feels great right now. It's surreal. I don't think it has kicked in yet." - GRAND FORKS HERALD ARTICLE (9/15/15)
