Starting with the 2011-12 school term, all fine arts judges need to complete an online rules clinic in their area in order to be placed on the certified judges list. Fine arts managers and judges have received increased scope in determining rules and handling appeals. Therefore, it is important to our schools that we ensure professionals have up-to-date information.

Please review the following screenshots for locating and completing your rules clinic. If you would like to enter mailing address and judging information, please select the 'Additional Judge Info' link on the 'Officials and Judges' page of your activities website. Please remember that once submitted, this information is on our public website.

Judges and coaches must request the 2011-12 judging role for which they have a completed clinic(s). Valid email addresses must be used in MVP account creation or update. This is the way judges will receive information from NDHSAA. All judges may take clinics during school windows or throughout the season. Coaches will be placed on the certified list(s) upon clinic completion and appropriate judge role request. Certification lists will be updated and posted periodically throughout the year.

There is no cost to you to complete the clinic. Clinics take approximately ½ hour. Thank you for your shared expertise and continued support of our State's students!

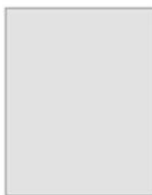
