

## SWIMMING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

April 10, 2012

### Recommendations:

1. Continue study of relay take-off pads for the a possible use in future seasons.
2. Clarify times for Diving warm-up to be 11:00 @ pool without separate diving well and 12:15 @ pool with separate diving well.
3. Following deadline for state entries, the first communication with coaches is by sending a pdf of their individual entries rather than total entries. This is done for coaches to verify the accuracy of their own entries prior to seeing the total entries.
4. Eliminate specifying the meet referee, diving referee and starter specifically must be NDOA registered and require all officials including stroke & turn officials must be registered.

### Points of Emphasis:

1. Emphasize the use of numeric grades in the Hy-Tek system.
2. Clarify the printed name on an electronically submitted dive entry sheet is legal. Also emphasize the dive sheets do not have to be submitted when the swimming entries are sent but must meet entry deadlines.
3. Coaches must consider the safety of his/her diver having them compete in the event they qualify for the state meet via a consideration 6-dive meet.
4. When submitting relay entries for the state meet, no names are to be listed on the relay entry.
