- 1. We ask that the NDHSAA staff be directed to do a study/comparison of football coop enrollment calculations where a team's enrollment and division placement be determined by a formula where 10% of the guest school's population be counted in the enrollment for each participant they send to the host school, up to 100%. For example if the cooped school sends 3 players, then 30% of their enrollment is counted, 7 players, then 70%, and so on. We ask that the office share this information with the membership, and with the football committee for the consideration and possible adoption of this formula for calculating enrollments in future football plans.
- 2. We ask that students in schools who are not in a coop be allowed to participate in football in another school that shares a boundary with their district of residence. The students would have to declare their intent to participate. If a student wished to change teams after participating, that student would be subject to transfer eligibility rules. The 10% per participant enrollment factor could be used in this situation. This would allow students living in the western part of a district to play on a team to the west and the students living in the eastern part of a district to play on a team to the east. The goal is increased participation and decreased travel for participants.
