- a. Discussion —

concerned that VB and FB would hurt – Mike Opdahl recommended we do an athlete survey as opposed to coaches, AD, and administrator survey as to get a feel for what our athletes think, (have the survey required)

also concern about getting on courses in Fall

- Minimum yardage for Region and Individual Qualifiers

- a. "A" Girls have minimum of 5000 yards

- b. Region 2 Boys average distance is 6,098 yards

- i. Hillsboro, Rose Creek, Oxbow, Carrington, Cooperstown, Mayville, Casselton

- ii. Discussion

Nobody expressed any concerns on any distance minimums. Most thought it was fine the way it is, but it didn't appear that there were any issues with having a minimum distance somewhere around 6,000 yards.

- vi. Region 6 – **11 teams**

- Next year Region sites – All Regions must declare sites

- **Coaches Playing at regular meets**

Mix reactions on this one

All Regions said they played

Most Regions don't play during Individual qualifiers

No one plays at the Team Region

Some coaches feel that their coaching is done during week, not at meet

Some coaches feel they should marshal while others said if they have to marshal, then they can't coach anyway

I mentioned that I played this year, but won't next year because I will have a young group of guys – meaning it probably depends on what coach thinks is best for his guys

- **New Business**

There was concern for lack of officials at State Meet

Concern about official scoring at State – we ended up having some issues on Wednesday because Iwanamaker was failing

Thought we should have marshals on every hole on state meet

Some coaches though coaches should be marshals, but then others said we can't coach then

Was agreed that the hosting course needs to find as many volunteers as possible to help with scoring, marshals, officials, etc.

Was mentioned Carrington has a great way of doing this

Also mentioned paying all courses for meets so it would be easier to get on them
