

## Soccer Advisory 10/15/15

- Discussion – Decline of red card in boy’s soccer. A thank you from the NDHSAA for promoting good sportsmanship.
- Discussion – Reminder of officials survey will be sent next week. It is sent early due to conflict with college season
- Discussion – Nate Ulness will be submitting a rules change proposal to the NFHS – It will go through the NDHSAA office.
- Discussion – The use of a single division in boy’s soccer. Best 8 teams will participate in the state tournament. Issues with travel, increase costs and increase loss of school time. Not enough interest to pursue at this time.
- **Items to go before athletic review / Board of Directors**
  - 1) Change the scoring system, for the current 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 points for loss, to 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 points for a loss. Rationale – 3 points is the norm for most wins today including the girls in ND.
  - 2) There is an interest to extend the boys season by one week. The week would be added to the beginning of the season. Rationale – 19 games in 9 weeks is very taxing on the student athlete. Playing three matches in a week does not promote good soccer and it puts undo physical and mental stress on the student athlete.
