

**MINUTES**

**General Assembly Meeting**

**North Dakota High School Activities Association**

**October 27, 2020 – via Conference Call**

The General Assembly of the North Dakota High School Activities Association met via conference call on October 27, 2020. President Jordan called the meeting to order at 3:30 pm.

President Jordan welcomed member schools to the NDHSAA General Assembly. Thanked member schools for joining this meeting and for all the work they have done for students in this crazy year.
