Dakota Bowl XXIII featured several highlight-reel worthy plays.

One play in particular – a 34-yard, one-handed, diving touchdown catch made by Bismarck Century senior wide receiver Adam Geiger – received national attention as it made ESPN's Top 10 Plays Countdown on its nightly SportsCenter broadcast on November 13, 2015.

Geiger's catch was also featured on ESPN.com and was compared to a similar high-profile catch made by New York Giants wide receiver Odell Beckham Jr.

Geiger caught a total of seven passes for 127 yards and two touchdowns helping Bismarck Century to 28-21 win over Minot for its first North Dakota Class 3A state championship.
