Meeting Chairperson: Clarke Ranum, NDHSAA Board Member

District 1-----Rick Jacobson, Wyndmere HS, Supt.

1. Implement a mercy rule in basketball -- A running clock would be utilized when there is a point spread of 35 points or more at the end of the third quarter or thereafter. Once begun, the running clock will be stopped only for team, official, or injury time outs, and for technical fouls. Once a 35point differential is reached the running clock will continue even if the differential falls below the 35 points.
2. Equal representation of officials for regional tourney between the two districts involved. Example — if there are four officials used for the regional tourney then two of them should be from one district and two should be from the other district.
3. NDHSAA should determine the color of the volleyball for next year.

District 2-----Steve Hall, Kindred HS, Supt.

1. Three Class Basketball: Please make a decision one way or the other and leave it alone.
2. Eliminate the upcoming summer coaching restrictions in regards to baseball and softball.
3. Make available MVP website to parents, student, and public to view stats and such.

District 3-----Patti Aanenson, Larimore HS, AD

1. NDHSAA pay for Regional Wrestling Team Dual plaques
2. NDHSAA pay for Regional Team Football plaques
3. Using colored volleyballs at Regional and State - what is the decision?

District 4-----Matt Fetch, Grafton HS, AD

1. Move Class "B" boys and girls golf to the Fall.
2. Use a white volleyball for all post-season tournaments

District 5-----Matt Herman, Ellendale HS, Prin/AD

District 6-----Les Dale, Ashely, HS, Supt./AD

1. Allow "sport specific" open gyms - safety reasons.
2. Football playoffs - Like seed and like regions, the top team is home team in odd numbered years and the bottom team is home team in even numbered years.
3. Football playoffs - have playoff information available much earlier.
4. Stay with the white ball at the State Tournament (or have everyone use the same balls)
5. Even out the number of teams in each district
6. Captains, Coaches, and Officials meeting with 20 minutes on the clock- start immediately. Each set of officials is doing this differently.

1. Motion to leave girls and boys basketball seasons where they are currently.

3. Motion to have unlimited substitutions in volleyball.

1. Reduce the number of weight classes in wrestling for Class B to 12 with the following classes: 107,114,121,128,135,143,152,162,173,182,200,285
