- Spectators must wear appropriate clothing. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited at all contests.

2000 NDHSAA Class B Girls Basketball State Champions Starkweather/Munich Magic Storm

The 2000 NDHSAA Class B Girls Basketball State Tournament played at the Bismarck Civic Center featured a talented field of eight teams sporting а combined 189-11 record entering tournament play.

Kindred (22-3), Larimore (22-3), Linton (24-1), Starkweather/ Munich (25-0), Washburn (24-1), Mohall (24-1), Dickinson Trinity (25-0), and Trenton (23-2) all converged on the

In only the fifth season of the Starkweather/Munich co-op, the program found itself in a state championship


capital city in hopes of winning a state championship.

Top-ranked all season, and eventual state champions Starkweather/Munich, coached by Karla Kitsch, would matchup with a talented Linton squad in the quarterfinals. Linton, ranked No. 3, entered the state tournament averaging 68.2 points per game, but the Becks of Starkweather/Munich proved to be too much for the Lions. The Magic Storm grabbed full control of the game closing out the second quarter on a 10-2 run, giving them a 28-14 halftime lead. The Magic Storm never looked back and cruised to a 54-40 win. The Becks accounted for 46 of the Magic Storm's 54 points. Rachel Beck led the way with a double-double, scoring 16 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. Sister, Monica Beck had eight points and four rebounds, cousins; Jessica Beck contributed 12 points and four rebounds, and Karla Beck came off the bench adding 10 points. While senior point guard Lindsey Haaven chipped in with six points and three assists.

Rachel, Jessica, and Karla Beck were all named to the all-tournament team.

1974 NDHSAA Class B Girls Basketball State Champions Hankinson Pirates

After а decade-plus long hiatus of no high school girls basketball state tournaments in the state of North Dakota. the 1974 season would usher in a new era for the sport.

Beginning in the fall of 1974, schools participating in the sport of girls basketball were divided up into two classes (Class A and Class B) with each cul-

minating in a separate state tournament.

The 1974 Class B State Tournament would be played at the Minot Municipal Auditorium. The tournament field consisted of McHenry, Kulm, Starkweather, New England, Central Cass, Noonan, White Shield and Hankinson.

Only one squad, the Hankinson Pirates entered the state tournament undefeated with a 16-0 record after defeating Oakes 41-27 in the Region 1 Tournament to earn a trip to the state tournament that would prove to be very successful.

Hankinson, coached by Nancy Johnson, featured a roster full of multi-sport athletes that had contributed to the Pirates' Class B girls track and field team state championships in 1972 and 1973. The team also featured three sets of sisters (Deb and Cathy Mauch, Melanie and Holly Heitkamp, and Lori and Deb Smith) who provided the squad with ready-made chemistry needed to make a run in the postseason.

Leading the way for the Pirates was senior forward Becky Boll who averaged 27.7 points per game and 18.7 rebounds per game. Hankinson also featured junior London Reile who also averaged double figures in scoring (17.4 ppg) and posted a 9.1 rebounds per game average in 1974.

At state, Hankinson would matchup with White Shield in the quarterfinals and cruised to a 73-51 win over the Warriors. dominating play once more. Reile led all scorers with 34 points and added 11 rebounds while Boll finished with 23 points and 15 rebounds.

Waiting for the Pirates in the state championship game was a talented McHenry squad that had edged Starkweather 39-32 in the semifinals to earn a trip to the state title game.

In the title game, Hankinson overwhelmed McHenry on the glass outrebounding the Blazers 63-25 that led to the Pirates to a 51-43 victory for the coveted NDHSAA Class B state championship in front of an announced crowd of 3,700 fans. Boll accounted for 26 rebounds in the championship game and poured in 15 points on the offensive end. Reile finished with 19 points and 16 rebounds. Despite the lopsided advantage in rebounds, Hankinson and McHenry were even on the scoreboard much of the first half. The Pirates first lead of the game came via a made putback by Reile off a missed free throw attempt by Lori Smith with four seconds remaining in the first half to put Hankinson up 22-21.

Hankinson would pull away in the second half to complete the undefeated season with a 19-0 record. Reile finished the tournament scoring 80 points and 38 rebounds. 
