

VB Scorer Responsibilities

Pre-Match

1. Report to the first referee no less than 20 minutes before starting time
2. No later than 10 minutes prior to the end of pre-match warmup, receive each teams roster. When discovered, the scorer shall report any inaccuracies to either referee
3. No later than two minutes prior to the end of the pre-match warmup and no later than one minute prior in subsequent sets, enter on the scoresheet the uniform numbers of the starting players in the proper serving order. Prior to each set of the match, the scorer shall provide the second referee with a lineup, which lists the player's numbers and the serving order of each team. The information shall be made available to the libero tracker
4. Print the first referees and second referees names on the official scoresheet.

Position

1. The scorer shall be seated at the officials table between the libero tracker and the official timer

During the set

1. Record individual and team scoring and supervise the operation of the visual scoring device.
2. Notify the second referee during the dead ball when there is a discrepancy with the score
3. Verify the serving order to the first referee or second referee
4. Provide the proper serving order upon request of the first or second referee during a dead ball
5. Sound the audio device at the time the ball is contacted for the serve when there is an improper server
6. Keep a record of time-outs charged to each team and notify the second referee how many time-outs each team has used at the completion of each team time-out.
7. Record in the comments section of the scoresheet all warnings, penalties and disqualifications for unsporting conduct violations, notify the second referee of any previous unsporting violations recorded for the same individual.
8. Record in the comments section of the scoresheet all penalties for unnecessary delay warning and/or penalties; notify the second referee if this is the second or subsequent unnecessary delay for a team in the same set
9. Record in the comments section when a player is removed from the set under concussion management.
10. Record in the comments section of the scoresheet the number of any player replaced by exceptional substitution and a redesignated libero.
11. Record each substitution as it is reported by the second referee. Immediately notify the second referee if a substitution is a request for a
 - a. 15th, 16th, 17th or 18th substitution
 - b. 19th entry (illegal)
 - c. Re-entry in wrong service position
 - d. Re-entry of a disqualified player
 - e. Re-entry of an injured/ill player during the same set in which he/she was replaced by an exceptional substitution
 - f. Player not listed on the roster
12. Not count an illegal substitution as one of the the 18 entries allowed per team
13. Notify the second referee when a team reaches set point
