Level 2 Amended: In-Person, Adjusted Scheduling and Format

- Maintain qualifying ratios per regulation. Ratios assigned to specific category.
- Schedule is blocked by school. This would allow for only one/two schools on site at any one time and minimize contact between judges/sites/participating schools.
- Schools with location proximity closer to festival site would be scheduled earlier or later in the day to allow for with further proximity ease of travel.
- No audience will be allowed on site – the event is limited to performers, judges, accompanists, and teachers
- **All** personnel will be masked (except for wind players when they are performing).
- All wind instruments will have bell covers.
- When not performing, participants will be directed not to congregate in hallways and should return to the staging area, school bus, or leave the festival site.
- Performance groups will be limited to a max size of 12 performers.
- Wind instrument performance sites will be set up for 6 feet of social distancing between performers.
- Judges tables and chairs for the director in the performance site will be at least 12 feet from the performers.
- Cleaning procedures (wiping down surfaces, fogging rooms) will be done at each performance site between each school's time block.
- There will be four performance sites and one staging area:
 - Band Room – Saxophone Ensembles
 - Choir Room – Saxophone Solos
 - Orchestra Room – Percussion Solos
 - Auditorium – Percussion Ensembles
 - Black Box/Double Classroom/Hallway – Instrument Storage/Warm-Up Area
- Entrance/Exit Procedures
 - Schools/performers will enter through Door 9.
 - Schools/performers will exit through Door 7.
