

Shot-Clock Displays

Art. 1. Two visible shot clocks, one at each end of the court, shall be mandatory.

Art. 2. An alternate timing device shall be available when a visible shot clock malfunctions.

Art. 3. A shot clock shall be recessed and mounted on the backboard supports behind each backboard.

Note: When the shot clocks are not placed in this location, if possible, they shall be mounted on the wall and positioned to the left of each basket as viewed from the center of the playing court. As a last resort, they shall be located on the floor at each end of the playing court so that they are visible to players, officials and the shot-clock operator.
